FRENCH GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS CALL FOR APPLICATIONS - PRACTICALITIES

Eligibility criteria

- Kenyan students holding a Bachelor or Master Degree and willing to further their studies in France;
- To have identified a relevant academic program and contacted the French Host University;
- For programmes taught in French language : a minimum level of B2 in French language (DELFB2) is compulsory (proof required)
- Employer's agreement (if any)
- Financial plan indicating co-funding (self-sponsoring, study leave, other scholarship)

Priority areas

Applications from all academic disciplines will be considered. However, priority will be given to the topics listed below, in accordance with the Kenyan "big 4" priorities:

Manufacturing	Engineering sciences / Technology / Agroindustry / Energy resources
Universal healthcare	Medicine and health sciences
Affordable housing	Civil Engineering / Engineering sciences / Technology
Food security	Agricultural Sciences / Veterinary Sciences / Forestry Sciences

Scholarship package

The scholarship includes:

- Monthly allowances
 - o For Masters scholarship holders : from September 2019 up to June 2020.
 - o For PhD sandwich scholarship holders: 3 annual stays (of 3 months each) in France over a period of 3 years from 2019. The third stay shall include the thesis defence in its organization.
- Social and health insurance;
- Round-trip airfare;
- Schengen visa fees;
- Tuition fees in French public universities (*it is to be noted that for private universities, the extra cost will be borne by the scholarship holder*);
- Facilitation of the access to affordable student housing.

Responsibilities of the French Embassy and Campus France

The French Embassy in Kenya and the local office of Campus France in Nairobi are responsible for providing information about the selection procedure, for selecting the scholarship holders, for booking their international trip, and for forwarding their file to Campus France Paris.

Campus France Paris is in charge of welcoming the grantees, disbursing the monthly allowances at their arrival, booking their accommodation (if required).

Assessment procedure

Applications will be assessed by a French-Kenyan scientific committee on the following criteria:

- Excellence of the applicant's profile
- Priority areas
- Complete state of the Application

Candidates will be informed of the decision concerning their application during the month of February 2019. Pre-selected candidates will be called for an oral examination to pass in front of the selection committee. The scholarships will be officially attributed after the admission of the candidate at the selected French university will be confirmed.

FAQ

Do I have to be fluent in French language to apply?

For applicants willing to register to a program taught in French, a minimum level of B2 is required. Proof of your level in French is compulsory. For more information, contact Alliance Française of Nairobi at info@alliancefrnairobi.org, they will give you the more information about the T.C.F. (Test de Connaissance du Français) and DELF.

French Universities offer more and more programs taught in English, where non-French speaking students are welcomed. If you apply to a program taught in English, you don't need a French certificate. Nevertheless **it is strongly recommended to applicants to learn French before their first stay, and to attend more classes once they reach France.** This will enable them interacting with French people, as well as discovering and understanding better French culture and way of life.
